Our Curriculum

Maths:

EYFS:

The children will be starting the term by building on their counting skills. The children will be continuing onto the numbers 9 and 10. This will include finding an amount, recognising the numbers 9 and 10 and identifying pictorial representations of these numbers.

The children will then move onto exploring 3D shapes. The children will learn to identify 3D shapes and identify 2D shapes within 3D shapes. The children will also continue to explore 3D shapes within patterns.

Year 1 and 2:

The children are going to start the term by looking at statistics. The children will be using different graphs (tally charts, block diagrams, pictograms etc.) to record information, but also using these different graphs to read interpret the information provided.

The children will then move on to consolidate their learning.

The children will then move on to look at money. The children will learn to identify different denominations of money and count in pounds and pence. The children will also be comparing amount of money and calculating with money.

The children will end the term by looking at fractions. The children will learn to identify different fractions and split an amount into the equal parts required to make a fraction. The children will begin to look at equivalent fractions and counting in fractions up to a whole.

Times tables :

This year, we will continue to focus on times tables. It was a government expectation that by the end of Year 2, all children should know their times table and division facts for the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables. To continue to support the children with their times tables they will be singing songs and doing times table focused activities as part of their Maths lessons.

Throughout the year, the children will continue to be tested on their times tables to further boost/secure their knowledge and also give them an opportunity to earn their times tables certificates.

English:

EYFS:

This term EYFS will be looking at the topic Amazing Animals. As part of this topic, we will be reading books about fictional and real-life animals. This term we will be moving onto reading, writing and matching CVCC. The children will be beginning to write sentences including capital letters and full stops. At the end of the term, the children will be exploring instructions and how to make pancakes.

Year 1 and 2:

This term the children are writing with the purpose to entertain. The children will start the term by writing a description about their lost dragon so that the brave knight can find it. The children will then move on to retell a classic tale and write their own classic tale at the end of the term.

Phonics:

Phonics lessons will take place twice a day for all children within the class. The children will be learning new sounds along with consolidating and recapping old sounds.

Spelling Shed:

To help develop the children's spelling, we use Spelling Shed. This program has fantastic games/resources to help the children practice their weekly spellings. Weekly spellings are set for children in Year 1 and 2. The children will be given assignments every week based on a spelling rule and will then be tested in class on that rule the following week.

Science

EYFS:

This term, as part of their topic, the children will be looking at pets and other animals. The children will be identifying and labelling different animals as well as comparing two animals to see how they are the same and how they are different. The children will also be exploring how animals change as they grow older and what habitats they live in.

Year 1 and 2:

In Science the children will be building on their knowledge of animals including humans. During this unit, the children will be learning about exercise and why it is important. The children will also be looking at the importance of eating the right amounts of the right food and hygiene.

History:

EYFS:

This term, EYFS will be looking at a comparison between the Queen and King's coronation. The children will be looking at pictures from people in the past and present. With support, the children will be finding out facts about people from the past.

Year 1 and 2:

Our History topic for this term is Britain since 1066. The children will be exploring how the history of the UK has been developed by the Normans in 1066 and the subsequent change to life in towns and villages. The children will investigate our local links to King John and his lost treasure.

Homework

Homework will be set on a Friday and is due in the following Wednesday. The homework is always fully explained to the children and often recaps things they have been learning in class. The children will be sent home with a copy of the pick and mix grid which has the homework for the term on (this is also available on the school's website). Water Bottles
