Practice writing your numbers in words from 0-10.

Challenge

Make an easter hat. You can either decorate a hat or make a hat from paper. Take a picture of your hat and stick it in your book or bring it in to show us!

Challenge

Make your own Easter egg hunt at home with your adults and find the easter eggs around the house.

Challenge

Cook a meal using eggs as an ingredient. Take pictures of your finished product and stick them into your book for us to share with the class.

Phonics

Practice your phonics sounds with your adults at home. You can do this by looking at the sounds in your reading books, or you can log on to EdShed (log in provided in front cover of homework book).

Challenge

Design an easter egg. Draw an egg shape and fill it with a beautiful design.

Write a fact file about your favourite animal.

Topic Task

Draw or paint a picture of your favourite animal.

Challenge

Make your favourite animal out of boxes or spare materials you can find at home. Take pictures and stick them into your book or bring it in to show us!

Topic Task

Design a coat for a guide dog. Remember guide dogs need to be visible to other people so lots of bright colours are encouraged.

Challenge
