EYFS – Spring Term 1

Reading

You must read at least 4 times a week at home. Each time ask an adult to write a comment and sign your reading record.

Complete by: 15.01.24

Writing Task

Draw a picture of someone who helps you. This might be a doctor, a paramedic, a binman etc. Write a caption underneath to tell us what the hero is doing.

Challenge

Cut potatoes, or other vegetables, into shapes. Use paint and your vegetable shapes to make a picture with the prints the vegetables make.

Maths Task

Write all of the numbers up to 8 in words in your homework book.

Challenge

Do some research using books or the internet to research Florence Nightingale. What can you tell me about Florence Nightingale?

Challenge

Use rubbish and materials around your home to make a superhero costume! Take a picture and stick it in your book.

Challenge

Make pancakes at home! Decorate them with your favourite toppings. Take a picture of your pancakes and stick them into your homework book.

Phonics

Practice your phonics sounds with your adults at home. You can do this by looking at the sounds in your reading books, or you can log on to EdShed (log in provided in front cover of homework book).

Challenge

Create a collage in your book about a person who helps us. This could be a nurse, a doctor etc. Show me the tools they use to do their job, their uniform etc in drawings or pictures.

Complete by: 29.01.24

Topic Task

Paint or draw a picture of Florence Nightingale. Write some describing words you might use to describe Florence Nightingale.

Complete by: 05.02.25

Topic Task

Draw a picture of an adult at home that you think is a hero to you. Tell me about this adult.

Challenge

Find pairs of things around your house. This might be socks, gloves etc. Take pictures of them and stick them into your homework book.

Complete by: 12.02.25

Topic Task

Bake or cook something at home. Write the recipe in your homework book. You can also stick a picture in your homework book of your finished product if you want to.

Challenge

Write a small piece in your homework book about you. What are your dreams and goals? What do you want to be when you grow up? What have you achieved so far in your life?

Practice counting to 20.

Challenge

History Task

Research a castle from around the UK. Write a fact file about this castle in your homework book.

Science Task

Draw a picture of an animal in your homework book. Label the different parts of the animal on your drawing.

Challenge

Make a meal or bake something with an adult at home. Take photos and stick them into your homework book.

Complete by: 12.02.25

PSHE Task

Make a fact file about you. What challenges have you faced? What goals have you set out to achieve and how did you achieve them?

Challenge

Draw or paint a picture of you when you are older. Draw or paint a picture of yourself achieving a goal that you have set for yourself as an adult. This might a job you want.
